Their tour of the north west was made possible partly by the donation of \$1,000 from the Premier, with thanks to the Hon. Elsie Archer for her assistance.

PRESIDENTS' REPORT Two months is a long time at the club! Quite a bit has and is happening around the club and this is just some of it.

The **Honorary Consul for Germany** and France, *Dianne Bye* has retired and has handed over the job to *David Shelley* whose new contact details are elsewhere in this newsletter. We have invited both Dianne and David to the Kaffeeklatsch on the 24th June., to farewell Dianne and welcome David. I hope to see as many of you as possible for this afternoon tea from 2:00pm. I'll be making one of my giant Blackforest Cakes.

Last year, the committee, aided largely by *Bernie Siegemund*, put a submission to the then Government. for a grant We heard back from them as part of their election funding commitments and we were advised that we would be given a \$15,000.00 grant to assist with the refurbishment of the club if the Liberal Government was reelected. I would like to thank the Tasmanian Government for providing us with this funding and the committee is prioritising the club's requirements. We are looking at such things as the toilets, the floor in the front bar, painting the timber around the outside of the building, replacement of chairs and replacement of some of the cutlery and crockery in the kitchen. We recently received information and nomination forms from the Glenorchy City Council for the **annual volunteering awards**. We have never nominated anyone of the many deserving volunteers at our club and we weren't sure of the process and requirements. As well as this we only had a few days to return any nominations so Gabi and I made the decision to nominate *Martin Palecek*, our licensee, chef, barman, cleaner and general good bloke for an award. The category we chose was the highest, special award for long service above and beyond. I'm pleased to announce that Martin received his award from Mayor Kristie Johnston at a presentation at the DEC recently. Congratulations and thank you Martin.

Our club has many other long time **volunteers** who also deserve recognition for their years of service. I will be discussing the nomination of a number of our members for next year's awards. I'll make sure that we allow sufficient time to get the paperwork done and look forward to attending another presentation at which our club will be represented by our dedicated volunteers.

I have been corresponding with **Tas Water** regarding the new charges that they have hit us with. Our annual bill has gone from some \$1,200.00 to \$6,000.00. We have made arrangements to disconnect one of the three water pipes coming into the property, saving some \$2,000.00 a year after we pay for the disconnection. They will however not budge on the sewage charge which is for 2.5 times more sewage than the amount of water they supply to us. I will be escalating this to the ombudsman to try and get some common sense into the situation.
