PLEASE NOTE:

Only financial members are eligible to be nominated and vote at the AGM. All positions are declared vacant at the beginning of the AGM. In order to be nominated to an Executive position, a person must have served on the Committee of the Association for at least one year, within the last five years.

Vacancies exist for the Executive Officers of the Association: President, 2 Vice presidents, Treasurer and Secretary/Public Officer, as well as 12 Committee members.

"The constitution states that nominations of candidates for election as officers or committee members of the association shall be made in writing, signed by two members of the association and accompanied by the written consent of the candidate. Schweinefilet mit Biersosse Pork fillet with beer sauce

750g pork fillets
150 g Speck or smoked bacon pieces
2 spring onions, chopped
Salt and freshly ground black pepper
1 cup cream
½ cup beer
600g leeks, sliced
60g butter

- 1. Preheat oven to 200C
- 2. Trim the fat and sinews from the pork fillets and wrap the Speck or bacon around them, securing with toothpicks.
- 3. Heat a frying pan and brown the Speck-wrapped fillets on all sides.
- 4. Place the fillets in a baking dish and cook in the preheated oven for 15 minutes.
- 5. Remove the fillets and keep them warm.
- 6. Sauté the spring onions in the fat remaining in the baking dish. Add the cream and reduce by half. Add the beer and simmer. Season.
- 7. Remove the Speck from the fillets, finely chop it a set aside.
- 8. Lightly sauté the leeks in the butter and season them.
- 9. To serve, slice the fillet and arrange the slices on a bed of leeks, sprinkled with chopped Speck and pour over the sauce.
